PSU Bachelor of Arts (BA) and Bachelor of Science (BS) Requirements for new admits effective 1999-2000:

BA 12 credits in Arts/Letters (4 credits must be in Fine & Performing Arts), 12 credits in Sciences/Social Sciences (4 credits must be in Science), and 4 credits in foreign language numbered 203 or higher (28 total credits).

BS 12 credits in Sciences (excluding Math/Stats), 12 credits in Arts/Letters and/or Social Sciences, and 4 credits in Math/Stats; 8 of the 12 Science credits must be coursework with a lab (28 total credits).
